

## **Calgary Wildlife's Busy Season Kicks Off**

### **With Baby Shower Livestreams and Urgent Call For Support**

Calgary Wildlife is urgently calling for community support as it kicks off its busy season with its annual Baby Shower event. During the summer months, the organization takes in 6-7 times more animals than during the off-season, with daily intakes ranging from 10 to 35 animals.

To ensure these orphaned and injured wild animals receive the care they deserve, Calgary Wildlife has set an ambitious fundraising goal of \$30,000. This amount is essential to cover approximately two months of food and medication costs, ensuring the wellbeing of the animals under our care.

"We deeply appreciate the dedicated support of our community, particularly during our busiest time of year.," says Calgary Wildlife's Executive Director, Beki Hunt. "The funds raised during our annual Baby Shower event enable us to provide critical medical treatment and care for our young patients, giving them a second chance at life in the wild."

There are many ways to support this year's Baby Shower, such as participating in a 50/50 raffle or donating to a GoFundMe campaign for much needed baby incubators.
